

An Energy Performance Certificate (EPC) helps you understand how energy efficient your home is. It uses colour coded labels from A (best) to G (worst), similar to those on new home appliances.

It looks at things like insulation, heating systems and windows to rate your property between A and G

A more energy efficient home could help you:

- be more comfortable
- stay healthier
- save money on your heating bills
- reduce carbon emissions

How energy efficient is your home?

If you want to make your home more energy efficient, the best place to start is to check your EPC. An EPC will give you recommendations on improvements you could make, along with estimated costs and savings.

You may already have an EPC if you bought your home in the last 10 years.
